VISITOR CENTERS



A historic farmhouse and one of the original homesteads in the late 1800's, the Kramer House was so named due to the last family who occupied it. Originally, the homestead housed the Boettinger family – one of the original settlers in the Schertz area. Pulte Homes bought the land that was formerly the Kramer farm to develop the neighborhood subdivision of Kramer Farm. Pulte then donated the old farmhouse to the city of Schertz. The city decided to renovate the farmhouse to its original look to include original siding, a new roof, lighting, a/c and heating system as well as rebuilding the windows and repainting the house to its Victorian-era appearance.

Inside the farmhouse are a few antiques as well as pictures from past Schertz to present. Visitors to the renovated farmhouse have included present surviving generations of the Kramer family who reminisce about "eating in grandma's kitchen" and retelling stories of growing up in the area. Officially opening in 2009, it is the city's Visitor Center and Chamber of Commerce offices.

The Selma Stage Stop was established only three years after the founding of Selma, in 1847. Constructed between 1850 and 1852, the line was a partnership between brothers-in-law, John S. Harrison and William McCulloch. Their stage line was part of a network of competing stage lines and "star routes" that contracted with the United States Post Office delivering travelers and mail throughout central Texas. The Selma Stage Stop was one of the stops on Harrison & McCulloch's star route 6285 that ran from Austin to San Antonio and took 18 hours to complete. It functioned as a stagecoach stop until 1854 but remained as the Selma post office until 1906.

The stagecoach connected the new settlement to the vital transportation lines that carried passengers to the interior of Texas. During its service as the post office, the Stage Stop legitimized the administrative, as well as physical, existence of Selma. The Stage Stop is one of the few remaining buildings in Selma left from the settlement period. Listed in the National Park Service's National Register of Historic Places, the Selma Stage Stop is a vital piece of Selma's history, and the Central Texas Landscape. It is used today as the Selma Visitor Center as well as the office of The Chamber (Schertz-Cibolo-Selma) of Commerce.




